

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is, the adoption of the Vickers amendment to the Scofield amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Incidentally, it takes 25 votes on everything, since we're on appropriations, even amendments to the amendment. I think you already know that. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: I'm going to ask for a roll call vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right.

CLERK: (Began roll call vote.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Scofield, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SCOFIELD: I guess it would be a point of order because I think we need to clarify something that may be confusing people. Your statement that it's a Vickers amendment to the Scofield amendment is not correct and it may be confusing some people. It is a Vickers amendment to the committee amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, I stand corrected and I appreciate your drawing my attention to that. It's the Vickers amendment to the committee amendment. Mr. Clerk, roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 74-75 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Vickers amendment to the committee amendment fails. What do you have next, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on Section 11 which relates to the Department of Education committee amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, did you wish to comment further on the passage? Senator Scofield.

SENATOR SCOFIELD: I would move the amendment, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the advancement of the amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay
