That is stress. You have heard some of the Senators get up this morning and speak very angrily and I think most of you know anger comes from frustration, and then it reaches a point sometimes where it becomes depression. We read about the posse comitatus. Quite frankly we had a bill before the Government and Military Affairs several years ago that I voted against it. I didn't think there was such a thing as posse comitatus that could exist in the State of Nebraska, I really didn't, but now we find farmers in their frustration and these lame-brained idiots like the posse comitatus are going out and talking to them, telling them arm yourselves, defend your land, use guns, same type of revolution that Senator Chambers has talked about in the urban areas. I hate to see the farmers put in that position and I hate to think that if it comes about it came about because we couldn't spend \$50,000 to help those people who are trying to help themselves. I have said it a hundred times. I will never lift a finger to help anyone who won't help themselves but I will move heaven and earth to help someone who is trying to help himself. And maybe this program is flawed but I just finished reading a book called Bad Times Never Last But People Do and one of the things he said in this book, and it was Dr. Schuller's, is it better to do something flawed, with a flaw in it, if there is a flaw in this program, it is better to do it with a flaw than to do absolutely nothing flawlessly. And if those farmers get so depressed or so angry that they take up arms, then I say it is going to be upon your shoulders and my shoulders because we couldn't squeeze \$50,000 out of this budget, and I am a 100 percent for budget cuts but you have got to have priorities the same as if you had a family. I will cut the family budget but I am sure as the devil not going to take out the food budget or the rent budget or the utility budget.
