

Section #27, I believe, 23, which relates to the Department of Roads and that is the Appropriations Committee amendment we're on and then I have an amendment from Senator Johnson to that amendment.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Because we really don't have enough working people here. We have good working people here, we just don't have enough people.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Then we go to Senator Warner for the committee amendments.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the committee amendment. All the...this is the General Fund \$1,500 that deals with the rail...rail planning studies and they have other funds that will suffice and it could be reduced so I move the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on that committee amendment? Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of the committee amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendment, Section 23, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendment is adopted. Senator Labeledz, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Now is it appropriate to make another motion that we adjourn until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock, inasmuch as 14 people are excused?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. You are adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
