Mr. Chairman. Previously, as I understand it, we have not allowed debate on a motion to...certainly not on a motion to adjourn. I don't recall any debate on motions to recess and while I'm not sure what the rule is, I think we are maybe setting a precedent here by allowing debate on a motion to recess and I think perhaps we might not want to do that. And if there is another way, Senator Landis has a motion, I believe, to suspend the rules which I believe maybe would be a better way to go. I hate to see us get every noon debating whether or not we're going to recess and that may be the result of the precedent we're setting here.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lamb, it is not a motion to adjourn, it is a motion to recess. The rules are silent on that question, but I appreciate your remark and, Senator Lynch, if you wish to restate your motion, you may do so.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a motion from Senator Lynch to postpone consideration of LB 1 until January 8, 1985, I'm sorry, 1986, January 8, 1986. That is a priority motion and it is offered by Senator Lynch.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Lynch, I believe you basically addressed your concerns. Would you like to further address them at this time?

SENATOR LYNCH: No, Mr. Chairman, I wouldn't. I don't think there is any need to take any more time of the Legislature.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Chambers, you were up when this whole thing began. Would you care to continue?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: However the motion is framed, it is the same general concern. However, with the change in the motion there is still propositions that we will still be down here day after day and I want to tell Senator Hefner something who thinks that some of us want the 50...we have special sessions and things to get \$55 a day. Senator Hefner, I'll make more by you all staying in special session than if you go out because as I told you, I come down here anyway and I'll get more by there being a special session when nothing is being done. I can do almost as much work upstairs because the only time I come down is when an issue that I think is important comes up or when a significant vote is to be taken. So if I just wanted to make the \$55 a day, then I would be in favor of us staying in special
