We need to think about those things because those are the kinds of trade offs and those are the kinds of decisions and those are the kinds of prioritizing measures that we are going to have to make some tough, tough decisions about now and probably next session, if we are indeed going to balance the budget, if we are indeed to stick with our target of cuts. So I simply want you to realize the kinds of choices you are making here and what your options are. So I would simply with that move the committee amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion before the body is the adoption of Section 28 of the committee amendments dealing with Game and Parks. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Please vote. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR BEUTLER: With a roll call vote or without?

SENATOR WARNER: Might as well do a roll call, I guess, to save time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, a call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
