SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, is there objection in the body to the withdrawal of the division of the question and a submission to the body of the question of the remaining committee amendments as a whole? If there is objection, we will not do that. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I object.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Senator Warner, are you...the call is raised. Senator Warner, are you ready to take up Section 36 of the committee amendments, state colleges, trustees?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I move the adoption of the committee's recommendation on Agency...what is it, Board of Trustees is the next one. Let me explain what the committee is suggesting. It is identical in both the case of the University and the state colleges. In both cases the 3 percent reduction in General Fund appropriation is identical to the Governor. The only additional provision that the committee is offering which would be included in this and that is that 1 percent by campus, both the University and the state colleges, be appropriated to the governing board, Board of Trustees, Board of Regents, providing those governing boards some flexibility if they choose to use it, some flexibility to use a portion of those funds at one of the different campuses within their system and that is only to provide a little greater flexibility as they address the issue of what the programs' activities will be eliminated. The total reduction...the Board of Trustees, Board of Regents could automatically put all the money right back to the campus if they chose to do so, but it does give them a little more management flexibility which both groups indicated they may not use but it could be helpful in the event they needed it. So I move adoption of the Board of Trustees and specifically when you adopt that it will show in the Board of Trustees' budget, because it is a separate agency from the state college budget, it would show that that 1 percent from each campus was still appropriated but appropriated to the Board of Trustees.
