

SENATOR HABERMAN: Call the question.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. All those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Let's vote so we can move along. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: We have ceased debate. Senator Warner to close on the motion.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the motion as explained.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion before the body is the adoption of Section 37 of the committee amendments dealing with the state colleges. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Please vote so we can move along. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that portion of the committee amendments.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Section 37 is adopted. Senator Warner to address Section 38 of the committee amendments.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the committee amendment that deals with the University of Nebraska. The concept is the same, it is an overall 3 percent reduction, but 1 percent by campus is allocated to the Board of Regents to redistribute between campuses should they find it necessary. I move its approval.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, just to briefly state I am voting for these and I am going to vote to advance the bill. I am doing it with the understanding I think which a lot of people have in here that on the matter of the state colleges, the matter of the University, what the ultimate cuts should be, what the final format of where we get our money, we will decide on Select File and, basically, we are trying to get this done as a processing matter and it is not necessarily the reflection that we think 3 percent is too
