

SENATOR HABERMAN: I call the question.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Please vote. Is there anybody else that wishes to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Debate is ceased. Senator Warner.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, the motion is the adoption of Section 38, I believe, of the committee amendments dealing with the University of Nebraska system. All those in favor of the adoption of this portion of the amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Please vote, one way or the other, so we can move on. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 13 nays on adoption of that portion of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, Section 38 is adopted. Members of the Legislature, we have three more sections to go and what I would personally prefer is to proceed to do those three sections and then quit for the day. So let's take up the next section, and if any of you have objections with just going through with all three sections, come up and see me and we will discuss it. But for right now, Senator Warner, let's take up Section 41 of the committee amendments on the State Patrol.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the committee amendment. It's the same as the Governor's.
