SENATOR CHAMBERS: And they track each other, I want it to be clear that I'm not trying to amend the committee amendment now but it is going to the bill.

CLERK: Thank you.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I would be interested in knowing the Chair's ruling as to whether or not this is in fact a reconsideration and whether or not Senator Chambers would be entitled to make that motion since he was not on the prevailing side on those various issues.
