That is what Osborne is trying to tell you all. Give me a University that the football team can be proud of. So when I go out to California or send somebody out there because I am not supposed to know these things and he tells a player, say you are coming here for the education. The player will say, well, coach, I don't know much about nothing but I have been reading in the paper where in Nebraska you all don't spend much money on education so I am not going to say that is why I come there. He will say, well, there are other schools that don't have education and they try to get you. And he says, yeah, but these schools offer me something. He will say, look, buddy, you are streetwise, aren't you? We understand, they then gives him a wink, "tch, tch", and here comes this running back sought by schools all over the country coming to Nebraska. Why? Because they have got a good Business Administration course. What are you going to take? A general education. That is what happens. Players got new cars. Go over there on the campus and look around. Nobody knows where they come from so they ask him, where did you get the car. My mother gave it to me. Okay, that ends the discussion. And we sit around here more worried about whether the football team is going to go on probation than we are about whether the kid is going to graduate with an education. Tell Dr. Tom, I said don't worry about that, and if he has problems, I have been around. I will work with him on that. I am trying to work now on the academic side and I am having more trouble here trying to get us to do what a university is to be about than I would in trying to help keep a football program strong but we have our priorities, all of us. I am going to vote to strike this provision. I know that I am whistling in the wind, and this final comment on this one. There is a song that says you don't tug on...you don't...I forgot it. (Laughter).
