

this one, this amendment deals with the state colleges and again I think the wrong kind of message is being sent and we can say that on Select File this is going to be done and that is going to be done but there is no need to do this now. Why don't you cut it out, cut this one out, and then let there be all the discussion back and forth, and decide to put it back in if that is what is to occur, and let the discussion be based on that, but not taking these educational matters which are very important and bury them among all these other items and they get lost in the hustle to get to the turkey shoot. Part of what I am doing is based on the idea that the Legislature having been called back by the Governor is behaving in a way that I don't think it should. Maybe I shouldn't be so critical of people going on a turkey shoot from here. Maybe that is their way to deal with the situation we find ourselves in, in being ordered by the god of politics to come back here and sit down here and go through all of this. But I wanted us to leave and the others wanted to stay and discuss it. They said it is hard work. It is tedious work. It is painful work. And I am doing all I can to help fulfill those prophecies or characterizations. I am going to stay with you here and, Senator Hefner, I am going to get my \$55 a day, and although it is in the way of expenses and not salary, I am going to earn it, and while I am talking, I think what we ought to consider doing is having these envelopes that our checks come in reduced, we should have it about one-fourth this size and the check one-fourth that size to better represent what we get in the way of a salary because this is misleading. I will bet the paper on which my check is written is as big as a piece of paper on which the Governor's check is written. That is how they trick people. If they put his in an envelope, I will bet his looks just like this. That is the way they do us. We get the same size piece of paper, therefore, that which is on the paper should be just as good. Now you probably didn't know how I was going to connect that to education again. If you get a piece of paper from a state college that says you graduated, it might be the same size, it might have flowers and ornaments and things that they put on those pieces of paper, and you might get a piece of paper from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln. Do you think that people in this state even accord the same value to one gotten from the state college as they do from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln? And if they do, suppose I can come up with one from the University of Harvard, which one automatically
