SENATOR BEUTLER: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And as a result of that, they are often victimized and they don't get even the opportunities that are out there available for them. If the state has a responsibility to look out for the welfare of its citizens, certainly we should from self-interest look out for the welfare of the young people. The less they know the less they are going to produce. The less they produce, the less revenue there is. The less revenue, the more problems, and you can argue it anyway you want to, but a mistake is being made by cutting these education monies, and I am going to, even though it is halfheartedly now, I am going to continue to fight against these cuts, and if the cuts are maintained or retained on General File, I will fight to try to get them taken away on Select, and I might tell you all what those words were that I said that I forgot. Senator Smith, sometimes I don't tell completely the truth. On significant things I do. On insignificant things like whether we ought to cut education, that doesn't amount to a hill of beans but the words are, "You don't..."

SENATOR BEUTLER: Time is up, Senator Chambers. Senator Vard Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, take heart, Senator Chambers, take heart, I will join the fight with you. There will be two of us, maybe there will be three, maybe there will be four, maybe there will be five. The time is coming for us to do what is right. Senator Remmers knows what is right. Senator Carsten knows what is right. I know, I have visited with them. There was considerable anguish in this legislative body about what we are doing at the bidding of our Governor to the state colleges and to the University and there are people in this body that are hoping that somehow and in some way the magic talisman can be found to reconcile competing interests and harm nobody. Sometimes the magic talisman can't be found and a man and a woman have to stand up and speak their minds and vote their convictions and vote their conscience and do
