SPEAKER NICHOL: May I request all of the Senators not in the Legislative Chambers to please return to the Legislative Chambers inasmuch as many of you have visitors in the north balcony to be introduced in a little bit and I would hate to introduce these guests without your presence to show your constituents that you are on time in attending the afternoon session. Have you all recorded your presence, please? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Before we begin the activities, I would like to introduce some guests in the north balcony. I would like to have you pay attention because some of them may be your constituents. We have 35 University of Nebraska students, Lincoln, and they are interested in the budget. They have come to watch you perform this afternoon. At present we are debating whether or not we should raise the cigarette tax from 18 to 23 cents and we are off on an
