

SENATOR DECAMP: Yeah, I want a vote on the bill to advance it to Select.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Senator Lamb, is that agreeable with you? All right. Do you have anything else on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Senator Beutler, do you want to offer yours to the committee amendments, Senator?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would just withdraw the two I have up there in light of that remark.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I have several lights here and I would ask if you wish to speak on the bill or if you had your lights on for the amendments that we were discussing, so if you have your lights on and you wanted to talk to the amendment, please take them off. But if you wanted to talk to the bill itself, then you are to leave your light on, please. Senator Higgins, you are next and we are back on the bill. The amendments have been withdrawn.
