

SPEAKER NICHOL: The debate has ceased. Senator DeCamp, did you wish to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I would just ask adoption of the committee amendments. I would ask that you advance the bill today. It is my understanding, in talking to Senator Barrett as related through you, that if it does advance that it would come up the day after tomorrow.

SPEAKER NICHOL: That is the tentative plan.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, I really think it is critical that we do advance the bill and I realize that there is going to be some bloody battles, probably, at the next stage but I think they are more manageable at the second stage than at the first. So if we could adopt the committee amendments and vote to advance the bill, it would I think be wise.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Okay, the question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Do you want to turn the lights off now, Mr. Clerk? Okay, now we are back on the bill itself and the advancement of the bill. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: I move it be advanced, and if there are no other lights, I would close by saying I move it be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any other discussion? All right the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to advance the bill to E & R for review.
