SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'm wondering, could I ask of the Clerk what the attendance is? Is there five excused? Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Five are excused.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, in closing I will only briefly capitalize what the motion is and that is to restore \$265,619 to the proposed appropriations for the state colleges for the current year. It is a 2 percent instead of a 3 percent. I think the discussion all morning long has, by and large, been on a level that was appropriate and I'm sure each of you know what you will want to do and further closing would not be necessary.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a request for a record vote. (Record vote read as found on pages 114-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Read some things into the record, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 3 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with E & R amendments; 5 Select File with E & R amendments and 14 Select File with E & R amendments. Those are all signed by Senator Hall as Chair. (See pages 115-16 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have a Reference Committee report referring a gubernatorial appointment to the Business and Labor Committee for confirmation hearing.
