SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. The difference between the amendments and the...

SENATOR HEFNER: And the green and the bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and the bill as introduced this special session?

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR HEFNER: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Higgins. Senator Miller is next.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Senator Beutler, I wish you were still Chairman of Judiciary Committee. I know that we would not have separate copies on our desk and wondering which one we are talking about all morning. I don't disagree with any of the questions that have been raised this morning about this bill or the committee amendments. And I think probably between now and Select File we better take a good look at the bill and there better be some amendments made to it. As a former employer myself, I, too, am concerned with some of the sections about withholding child support as ordered by a court. But for today and because we are looking at the loss of millions of dollars from the federal government if we don't move this bill in some form or other to comply with federal regulations, I would urge all of you, first of all, to save the state some money in the form of ADC, to advance this bill to Select File and by then I know that Senator Beutler will have the Judiciary Committee staff give us all a copy of a breakdown of the bill, section by section. I haven't even read it myself yet. So I would simply urge the advancement of the bill, the adoption of the committee amendments with the understanding that we probably will spend some time changing it on Select File as needed.
