

Legislature, I would have to say that I am not, of course, familiar with the committee amendments. I want to review them. I would have to say also that I've had a long interest in child support legislation. I am concerned about the tone of the bill. I am concerned about the direction and I would hope that before we get this bill across the board, those concerns are going to be resolved. I will not hold up the bill today. I will move to advance...or vote to advance the bill when that time comes. I think it is important enough that we should do that and I'd just say that I want to visit with Senator Beutler. I am sorry Senator Hoagland is not here, but those who have worked on the bill in the committee, and see if I can get my fears resolved and if so then I will go along with the bill even after Select File. But I am not going to keep the bill in abeyance today because I think it is important that we try to at least accommodate our division of social services to that extent. I think we need to resolve many of these questions, however, and the sooner we do it the better. Thank you very much.
