

SENATOR SCHMIT: And it is always one of the ploys of government, and the University is not immune from this, to take that which is most needed and most necessary and lop it off. I think that we should let them know that we do not like that. I think that we should point out that we will be holding them accountable and that certainly the school at Curtis is one of those institutions which needs to be considered not only because of its contribution to agriculture but because of its geographical location and its importance to the western part of the state.
