SENATOR CHAMBERS: I didn't know what you might want to do so I am going to let you finish whatever on this point you want to finish and then I will make a motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: But the motion to adjourn sine die is not debatable, so what I am going to do, Senator Chambers...Senator Chambers, what I am going to do at the moment is, since we are plowing new ground, I have never been in this situation, I don't know that anybody else has either, is to continue on the basis that we are operating under the expanded call of the Governor as presented to us a few moments ago, and then if after some of the others who wish to expound on the situation, a motion to adjourn sine die may be introduced in the near future. So those of you who wish to speak, we will call on you and have that discussion. Senator Schmit has not come back. Senator Vickers has not spoken. Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President and members, actually I put my light on because I thought this whole discussion was somewhat ludicrous and I had intended to call the question. But it seems to me that the debate obviously wants to go on awhile, so I might as well throw in my 2 cents worth too. Sometimes we wonder why we are looked at with such disdain by the public. I don't think we had ought to wonder too much longer. All we have to do is look at what we are doing.
