

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 136-37 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have another one?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, the amendment I have...

SPEAKER NICHOL: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, there will be a meeting of the Government Committee underneath the south balcony. Government Committee, south balcony. That is called by Senator Landis as Chair.

Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker and members, this amendment was offered before we adopted the 2 percent versus 3 percent University cut. I would have substituted the \$2.5 million saved by transferring 2.5 million out of the Highway Trust Fund. I still feel that the Highway Trust Fund has not been cut nearly as much as any other budget has and this would have been one indication of a way to make up for a higher budget for the University but we have made the decision on 2 percent so I would ask that this amendment be withdrawn at this time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is withdrawn. The next one, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is by Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp would move to suspend Rule 6, Section 5; Rule 7, Section 3, and vote on the advancement of LB 1 without further amendment or debate. (See page 137 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, please.
