

General Funds appropriated to this agency. And I think, hopefully, that will clarify that one concern and we can get the Auditor to carry out those audits as intended and not charge those counties, whereas other counties are given that audit free of charge and then we will have this other bill to deal with the other problems and clear up the lawsuits pending on the issue.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Would you like to close, Senator DeCamp? Anybody authorized to close for Senator DeCamp? Oh, okay.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, very briefly. I think it is time to get it settled because if you have noticed, we have not added any additional cuts the last three days. We have cut the cuts and if past history is anything, that is what will occur if you don't get the bill over. I suggest you get it advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the DeCamp motion which is to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please. Senator DeCamp. Call of the house has been called for. It takes 30 votes. All those in favor of going under call vote yes, opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber please return promptly and return to your seats and record your presence. Senator Warner, Senator Pirsch, Senator Peterson, Senator Scofield, Senator Rogers, Senator Chizek. Senator Pirsch and Senator Warner. Looking for Senators Warner, Pirsch and Chizek. We are looking for Senator Chizek only now. The other two are on their way. We are all here now and we are voting to suspend the rules so that we can vote on DeCamp's motion, Senator DeCamp's motion. So just record your presence and the question is the suspension of rules. Mr. Clerk.
