

CLERK: Senator, I just wasn't sure, forgive me. Mr. President, LB 10 offered by Senator Warner. (Read title.) The bill was read on October 17 of this year, referred to Revenue, advanced to General File. I have no committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Now, Senator Warner, you may make your motion, and so forth.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the bill be advanced. It is to adjust the income tax 1 percent. As written, I have an amendment filed which is written differently than to limit it to one year. But I would I guess like to take that amendment up because the intent of it, at least, is to limit the 1 percent to this year only and it would revert back to 19 percent then for 1986.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, a point of order.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, state your point.

SENATOR DECAMP: I believe this bill is outside the call of the session and I believe this bill is different than "the new call." I think this bill has to operate under the old rules. So this bill is clearly outside the call and I think Senator...didn't Senator Warner have a motion to make it within the call or something like that? Or how are we going to do this?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, I didn't hear what Senator Warner said.

SENATOR DECAMP: That's because he mumbled.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. Clerk, did Senator Warner say that?

SENATOR WARNER: Where are we at?

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, then I am saying this bill is outside the call and, of course, we are talking about the old call because the new call applies to the new bill introduced, as I understand it.
