SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, I didn't understand that we do have the new bill and the Clerk tells me we do have the new bill. Senator Warner, did you know that we have the new bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Yeah, I heard about it. Yes, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Oh, when you spoke, were you speaking about the new bill or the old bill?

SENATOR WARNER: Just now?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Just a little bit ago.

SENATOR WARNER: I was speaking to LB 10, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, did you wish to...

SENATOR WARNER: What I think I would like to do, Mr. President, is to move just to advance the bill and put my amendment on on Select File. And the reason is this, the amendment I have drafted identifies the 1 percent additional income tax for 1985 only as a surtax. It is 19 plus 1.
