SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, thank you, Senator Warner. You know, fellow legislators, we are asking...we are being asked to advance a bill that has been amended to Select File and then we are being asked also and being told that this isn't the bill we want on Select File. We want a new bill that is going to be introduced to be passed by the Legislature. So if they want the new bill that is going to be introduced, how are we going to get it in the millstream, have a public hearing and go through all of the proper procedures to replace the bill that we are being asked to advance to Select File?
