SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: I call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting to cease debate. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, would you like to close, or Senator Vard Johnson, either one?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: It is Senator Warner's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner's.

SENATOR WARNER: Again, Mr. President, the amendment just clearly limits the adjustment to the calendar year 1985 and I would move its adoption, then I can discuss the reasons for this as opposed to other alternatives on advancing of the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Warner amendment. Senator Warner. I think the Education Committee is coming, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Oh. I would ask for a call of the house otherwise, but if they are coming...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Perhaps you better proceed, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, request a call of the house.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the request is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.
