

Senator Landis instructs me to report that LB 29 has been advanced to General File with committee amendments attached and that is signed by Senator Landis. (See pages 142-46 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have a new bill, LB 35, introduced by Senators Warner and Vard Johnson at the request of the Governor. (Read title for the first time as found on page 146 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: We have a report coming in that we should get in, in today's meeting. SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Miller, since you are standing up and ready to go would you adjourn us until nine o'clock tomorrow, please.

SENATOR MILLER: Mr. Speaker, I make a motion that we adjourn this meeting until nine o'clock tomorrow morning.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It barely passed.
