PRESIDENT: Any discussion of the amendment explained? If not, all those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, opposed vote nay. Motion is the adoption of an amendment explained by Speaker Nichol. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Nichol's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Anything further, Senator Hannibal?

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Only, Mr. President, that the numbers now read around \$7,500 for this year and \$10,000 for next year. They represent the estimated data processing costs. In an effort to just make sure it is there, if and when LB 7 passes, I would move for its advancement.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill. Is there further discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is the advancement of LB 7A from General File to Enrollment and Review. Please record your vote. Some of you are in your seats who haven't voted, who may wish to vote. Obviously we need 25 votes to advance the bill. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The A bill is advanced. Next is LB 29e.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 29 was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) The bill was read on October 19 of this year. It was referred to the Government Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Government Committee amendments pending which is Chaired by Senator Landis.
