CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 158-59 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 23 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have any other amendments or...

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Vickers and Remmers would move to amend the bill. (Amendment is found on page 159 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, members, the amendment that I offer to you now is partially as a result of...well, it is totally a result...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Call is raised.

SENATOR VICKERS: ...of Senator Remmers' attempt to amend the bill on General File when he pointed out that parts of Section 2 were probably unnecessary. Upon further examination it would appear that Section 2 and Section 3, both, probably are unnecessary. So the amendment before you would be to repeal Section 2 and Section 3. Now I'm not saying we are going to strike them from the bill. I'm saying the motion is to repeal them from the statutes. Here is the rationale, since Section 2, if you will look at the bill, set up the mechanism to establish requirements for the certification of driver ed. instructors, and gave the authority to the schools to conduct driver education, based on the fact that we were going to apportion monies from the state to support it, there is really no need to have that language in this section of the statutes since we are already removing that language from that section as far as apportionment of funds are concerned. There are already other sections of the statutes that require the schools, if they choose to have drivers education which they may be able to do through their general broad authorities, to require them to have certified instructors. So removing this language would not affect the ability of a school district,
