SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, thank you, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers, would you like to close, please, on your motion.

SENATOR VICKERS: Just one more time to clarify that the schools would still have the ability, if they choose, to offer a drivers education program under the broad authorities that they already have; and also to indicate to you that if they make that choice that their instructors would have to be a certified teacher, again under the authorities in other sections of the statutes. Now as far as the private drivers ed. programs are concerned, they are licensed under the Department of Motor Vehicles, and that would continue to remain there. They would not be changed in any fashion under this amendment. This is...there will really be no change once we've made the decision we are not going to pay any funds, which is what LB 5 was all about. The rest of the sections, the language in these two sections, were simply redundant language because it was repeated in other sections of the statutes. So I would ask you to adopt this amendment to repeal those two sections from LB 5. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Vickers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senators Vickers and Remmers amendment.
