If not, the question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to adopt the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Do you have anything else on the bill, any other amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to ask your advancement of the bill. We have worked with the CPAs to work out the concerns that they had and we will be working with Senator Landis on further amendments to this area of the law and Senator Lundy is interested in pursuing it. The lawsuits are out there. We definitely feel that we need to address the issue. As for Senator DeCamp's concerns about the seven-day limit and what have you, I really don't think that will be a problem, but the bill was introduced the very first week we were down here and it has been pending before us and a hearing has been held and the amendments are minor changes to the bill.
