of today's activities. So with that, we will move on to a resolution by Senator DeCamp called LR 9. Okay, Senator DeCamp, do you have a point of information?

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, Mr. President, a request for information from the Speaker. Do I understand we will be taking up LB 1 Tuesday and will LB 1 be in a position to vote on it for final and send it to the Governor so, if we did want to react to vetoes, we'd have plenty of time?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Tuesday? Let me check with the Clerk to see if it's in shape. He informs me, if it is not amended, we could suspend the rules and vote on it Tuesday. Otherwise, I believe it would be Wednesday.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, then I would ask unanimous consent that it be put on the Tuesday Final Reading thing, at least for most to suspend the rules on it.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I think it will be there anyway. Senator DeCamp, it will be there. The only thing, I didn't want to say that it would be the only one that...

SENATOR DECAMP: Oh, fine, yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, I intend to have it there under motions because it does have one motion that I know of.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, then a final request from the Speaker. Mr. Speaker, one of the most important things that we will want to know when we come back Tuesday is the amount of revenue we have taken in, in October and I know everything I have tried to find out, there are no figures available. But through my underground sources I understand that, in fact, we do have some revenue figures and the revenue figures are substantially up about almost equal to the amount the cigarette tax would raise. So could we have, by Tuesday, through whoever can solicit those things and force some action, actual figures before the Legislature as to what the revenue picture is because that's what this whole session is about. And we have information, I believe, over there and it's already November 8th and I know, talking to people that have been in that office before, that this information should be clearly available by now. Could we get that?
