

SPEAKER NICHOL: That's a good question. Of course, I can't personally promise you that we'll have it, but we usually expect those out on the 10th and, of course, since the 10th is Sunday, the 11th is Monday and we'll be here Tuesday, I would think we'd have them sometime Tuesday, but we'll check to make sure that we have them if at all available.

SENATOR DECAMP: Okay, thank you very much.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. Incidentally, I should mention to you also that I visited with the Governor today and I asked him if we got all the Final Readings over there by Friday in a reasonable time, if he would let us know, also on Friday, what he has done with each bill and he said that he would. Incidentally, some of you know that some of the bills have priority status as far as being read. The Governor did say that he would hold all of the bills until Friday for his signature so that we will be knowing some time Friday, if we get the bills over there in a reasonable time, we will know some time Friday what his decision has been made. I have heard no clamoring for overriding his vetoes, if there should be any, but perhaps some of you do and, if you do, you should let me know so that we can hold you here later Friday in case you wish to attempt some overrides at that time. Of course you don't know at this time what he is going to do nor what we are going to do, but sometime along toward the end of the week, if you are leery about some of the things that we have done or wondering about what the Governor might do, let me know so that perhaps we can save time some time Friday for attempted overrides if you wish to do so. So that is the program at this moment. I'm not guaranteeing you that's the way it will unfold, but we can hope so. I appreciate your cooperation so far and it has been very good and you've worked diligently and I really appreciate it. With that, let's go into Senator DeCamp's motion on his resolution number nine.
