

of the two bills would be the appropriate one, I think LB 35 ought to be advanced in the sense of timing, if nothing else. If we are going to be able to complete Friday, this bill needs, and all bills that are going to be considered on Final Reading by Friday ought to be advanced now or today. LB 35...obviously if we are going to not have further complications for the state budget for '86-87, the necessity of one of the two bills being enacted are without question. I move the bill be taken up and advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, I understand we have an amendment. Is that right?

CLERK: Mr. President, technically we should read the title.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, would you read the title, please.

CLERK: LB 35 was a bill introduced by Senators Warner and Vard Johnson at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was first read on November 6. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President. I do have an amendment. Senator Rogers, the first amendment you gave me, Senator, I understand you wish to withdraw, the one we had printed.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Carson Rogers would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Carson Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: What page is that on?

CLERK: Well, Senator, your first one was on 169, that is the one with...

SENATOR ROGERS: The first one, on page 169, right in the Journal?

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR ROGERS: Okay.

CLERK: That is the one we withdrew though, right?
