SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland has advised me that several of you are working on LB 7 and asked that we pass over it for a few minutes until after LB 29. We'll do that momentarily at least. So let's take up LB 29.

CLERK: Senator, on LB 29 I do have E & R amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
