

SPEAKER NICHOL: Roll call?

SENATOR WITHEM: ...roll call vote, sure.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Thank you. Reverse order has been asked for on the roll call vote. Please look up at the board to see if your green light is on, if not record your presence. Thank you. Looking for Senator Beutler, Senator Chambers, Senator DeCamp, Senator Miller, Senator Haberman, Senator Goodrich, Senator Landis, Senator Hoagland, Senator Pappas. We are looking for Senators Chambers, Landis and Goodrich. I guess we are all here now but Senator Landis. Reverse order has been requested so, the question is, shall the bill be brought back for specific amendment? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Mr. Clerk.
