

All those in favor signify by voting aye. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The house is under call. Would you please come to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Senator Baack, Senator Wesely. Senator Wesely and Senator Baack, would you report to the Chamber, please. Senator Johnson, I understand Senator Baack is on his way and Senator Wesely is just walking in.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I'd just ask for a roll call vote then. We can just go ahead and call the roll.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Are you prepared to proceed at this point? Roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 188 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The amendment fails. Next, Mr. Clerk. We need to readvance the bill. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I move it be advanced.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Motion is to readvance the bill. All those in favor say aye. You are absolutely right, Senator Chambers, it is a debatable issue, unless we can keep the board closed. Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, since the Governor would call us into Special Session, that means we are prepared, yes,...

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The call is raised.
