

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is withdrawn. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, I...if you want to do it tomorrow, I would be happy.

SPEAKER NICHOL: But I wanted to get to number 7, too, today and we could do this tomorrow, unless you insist on wanting to do it today.

SENATOR DECAMP: Vard and Chris and a lot of them want to do it today and I don't care, I just want to get it done.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Just let me check the rules here to see if we can do it today.
