

SENATOR HIGGINS: I know.

SENATOR BEUTLER: The fact of the matter is we just haven't had time to sit down and think it through, Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: I realize that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Maybe next year...there is going to be some patch-up on this bill, I assure you. It's just...it is too complicated. Maybe next year when we do that we can draw a new line on that particular question.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, thank you, Senator. I think Senator Beutler is trying to do the best he can with a job that is horrendous, to say the least.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR HIGGINS: We have been trying so hard to improve child support collection. So at this time I think we separate the vote on the different sections that Senator Beutler has offered in this amendment and perhaps it will be easier for those who want to study it a little more. Thank you, Mr. President. I would ask that we divide the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. Senator Higgins, where do you want to divide it? Senator Beutler, do you understand where she wants to divide it? Okay, Senator Higgins, with your permission I will ask Senator Beutler to divide it. Is that all right with you?

SENATOR HIGGINS: All right. Senator Beutler, do you understand where I am coming from?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I believe so. If I understand Senator Higgins correctly, Mr. Speaker, we would ask that Sections 1 through 5 of the amendment be considered first and as one proposition and then that Section 6 which is on the back side of what has been passed out and which is in writing as opposed to typed be considered as a separate divided question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, we are talking about the first part of it now. Senator Goll, did you wish to discuss the first part of the amendment? All right.
