

you have a lien on a car, a mortgage for the next five years, you have got to make payments on the car. We owe as much to our children. Senator Beutler made the point also that it would be a much poorer bill with this amendment even though I had originally said this was the way to go. I said it was the way to go instead of taking out Section 2 or paragraph 2 of this section. So at this time, I do not support this amendment because I do want to be fair to the children and forget the husbands and the wives and everyone else. We have to think of the children. So I would urge the body not to adopt this amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, please.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: (No response.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Beutler, please.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I want to make some legislative intent clear at this point in time since we happen to be on this particular section, and it really doesn't have to do with Senator Johnson's amendment, but it does have to do with the language involved here, and I want to ask Senator Hoagland with regard to the specific language in line 7 on page 15, what the word "registered" means. The federal government is requiring us, as I understand it, to extend liens to personal property. Liens have not heretofore been upon personal property and now we are extending the liens because we have to to personal property and we are extending it to personal property that is registered with any county office. Now I think it is important, if we are not going to amend the language of this bill, that at least we have the clear intent of what that particular word known to those who are going to be interpreting the bill. I assume that personal property that is registered would include automobiles, is that correct? It would include automobiles if they are registered...all automobiles have to be registered.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: So it would include all automobiles?
