

done. So I would like to point out just a few things that I have found out of what we have done. First of all last week in 1985 and '86, you should have a copy of this, this bill would have cost us, General Fund and Cash Fund, \$7,500. It now cost \$34,333. In '86-87 this bill last week cost us \$10,000 in tax funds and now it costs us \$56,800. So we have increased the cost of this child support bill five times. We have increased the cost five times. Now you don't have a new fiscal note because you won't get it until after you pass the amendment, but I asked the fiscal people to give me an estimate of what are we doing when we pass this particular amendment, and that is what we are doing. We are raising the cost five times. Now I passed out a dissertation of this amendment and it says that Douglas County, Sarpy County, and Lancaster County will need one referee. Well, now next year is that going to be two and three referees? We don't know. And I will say, yes, it will because they said 50 percent of the cases are in those three counties. Now the rest of the counties can be handled by the county judges but it can't for some reason be handled in those counties. Now we are going to put in a computer system for this particular amendment. We are putting in a new computer system. We even tied the salaries, in Section 3 of my dissertation, not to exceed 70 percent of the salary of the county court judge. So here we go again, tying ourselves to a salary increase whether we like it or whether we don't. Now on page 2, Section 7, it shall be used by the Supreme Court to pay for child and support collection efforts. Any money available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer. What are we talking about? A few minutes ago you passed an amendment to put \$50,000 into this bill, 50,000 bucks, and this now says we are not going to use all this 50,000, we are going to invest it. Now who will use the money and what constitutes child and spousal support collection efforts? That hasn't been spelled out. So what I am trying to tell you at this late hour we are being pushed because of the federal government.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Hoagland said we are going to lose \$5 million. Well, I wonder if those three gentlemen could come up with a little simple bill to save the \$5 million and then next year give us some time to find out just exactly what you have done to us. Because there isn't
