Now I am for collecting child support, don't get me wrong, but I am against the rush, the push, the late hour, the number of amendments, the changing the bill, and the way we are going at the whole thing. So you say, let's just advance it to Select File and we will change it there. Now that is what is going to happen. I know you are going to advance it to Select File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Time.

SENATOR HABERMAN: And we are supposed to handle those things there. Well, we will have to take them up on Select File I guess, Mr. President. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, for what purpose did you rise?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker, let me ask leave of the Speaker to offer a substitute amendment. We had passed out before lunch the six-page amendment that I referred to and then a one page amendment to that amendment came out after lunch. Now the Bill Drafter's Office has just delivered down a computerized amendment that simply integrates those two, simply integrates those two amendments that were passed out, one before lunch and one after lunch, and I would like permission to substitute that for those two amendments. We could do it on a one vote that way. There has been no change in the language other than...there has been no change in the language that you have already received.

SPEAKER NICHOL: So you are withdrawing this particular amendment?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Withdrawing this particular amendment and asking leave to substitute another amendment that combines the two that were previously filed.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We will just withdraw this one and go to the other amendment then. Okay. Mr. Clerk.
