

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Do you have anything else?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are back to the advancement of the bill. Senator Peter Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker, I would move that the bill be advanced to Final Reading.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? If not the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 7.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Senator Hoagland, do you want to move the A bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, on the A bill, I have no E & R amendments. I do have an amendment pending by Senator Hoagland.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland, do you have the amendment please.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I am told by representatives of the Fiscal Office that we should pass this until tomorrow morning, Mr. Speaker, because one of the amendments to the bill is going to require some juggling in the A bill that has not yet been completely prepared. So if we could do the A bill tomorrow morning, Mr. Speaker, I think that would work better with the Fiscal Office.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, we will hold that over till tomorrow, that will automatically hold that over until Friday for Final Reading incidentally. Do you have anything, Mr. Clerk?
