

SENATOR ABOUD: And I think it is mistake at this time to do away with it. I urge this body to do away, to not enact LB 6 at this time. Mr. President, I am going to take off my motion to kill LB 6. I don't believe the votes are here at this time to do it but I would sure hope that people in here think about those homeowners when they are making their vote on LB 6 and vote against doing away with the homestead exemption. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You are withdrawing your motion? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marsh would move to return LB 6 to Select File for specific amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, Senator Abboud's action to make his 10 minute speech and then withdraw it leaves a little to be desired. I object to the misinformation he is trying to tell his constituents by saying that if we leave this there, it will help them with their property taxes. In fact, it will help raise their property taxes because there are no dollars this year or next to put into this particular type of legislation and he knows it. We also know that there will be unnecessary expenses mandated at the local level unless we remove this from the books because our local counties will have the responsibility of accepting filings and requests when they know and we know and Senator Abboud knows that that is an unnecessary expense at the local level and we can help them with their property taxes by removing this bill at this time. I ask to remove my motion so that we can vote on Final Reading on LB 6. Thank you.
