CLERK: (Read LB 29 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: Members, we are on Final Reading. Please, take your seats. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 29 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on pages 243 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 29 is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Proceed to LB 7 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (LB 7 read on Final Reading.)
