PRESIDENT: The motion is to reconsider the previous action on LB 3. All in those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, to reconsider.

PRESIDENT: The motion prevails. The question now is on reconsideration shall LB 3 pass without the emergency clause? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. You are voting on final passage of LB 3 without the emergency clause. Please record your vote. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 248-49 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 19 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill passes without the emergency clause. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 3. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing for the record, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I will be in touch with the Governor and invite him again to come back to visit with us. So with that, I move that we recess until two o'clock.

PRESIDENT: All right. The motion is to recess until...Senator Warner, did you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR WARNER: Just a question of information of the Speaker.
