

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not activated.) ...out of session again, so let us begin to reassemble. We are still technically on Final Reading. Members of the Legislature, please return to the Chamber and we will continue our deliberations. The Appropriations Committee is back to report. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Might I request we check in as we return?

Members, please record your presence on the board so that we can ascertain the acquisition of a quorum, in other words, as they say in Ogallala, find out if you are all here. Senators DeCamp and Eret, Chambers and...here we are, please record your presence. Senator Pirsch, Sieck and DeCamp and Eret. Senators Pirsch, Eret, Sieck and DeCamp. Senators Sieck, Eret and Pirsch. If we all come in it will be easy to move ahead without asking for technical calls of the house and so forth. Do you want to see where those senators are, Mr. Sergeant. Sieck, Eret and Pirsch.
