SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is carried. Mr. Clerk, do you have something to add to the motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, indeed, I do. I have a communication from the Secretary of State regarding the passage of Amendment #1 that appeared on the general election ballot this last week. The vote totals on that particular issue, those voting for, 223,714; those against, 228,777. That communication will be inserted in the Journal, Mr. President. (See pages 4-5.)

Mr. President, I also have from the Secretary of State an official roster of the membership for this Third Special Session of the Eighty-Ninth Legislature. (See pages 5-7 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have a series of appointment letters received from the Governor's Office regarding appointments to various state boards, agencies, and commissions. Those will be referred to the Reference Committee for referral to the appropriate Standing Committee for confirmation hearings during the activities of this special session.
