

SENATOR DECAMP: It is not. In fact it may require an A bill, I don't know. That was an addition brought in at the last minute and we found out we would have funds available, more than enough funds available, and the question I guess is whether the Secretary of State can go ahead and just simply do this without a specific A bill or not.

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, it is my understanding that an amendment to LB 2 is actually prepared to reflect what we are doing in LB 1.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes, right. Senator Warner, would you like to respond to Senator Hall's question? Is that okay with you, Senator Hall?

SENATOR HALL: That is fine.

SENATOR WARNER: Well, Senator DeCamp has essentially...there is an amendment. It will probably be up there later this morning or first thing in the morning for LB 1 and it would merely reflect what the revised cost will be.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, that is up there on the Clerk's desk if you would like to have a look at it.
