You are absolutely right. But I don't think that is really the case. I think we do need to let those folks know, yes, in fact, we do care about you. Yes, in fact, we think you are capable business people. It is not all your fault this happened to you and we are not going to create more hoops for you to jump through. Instead, we are going to make it somewhat easier for you. I ask for adoption of the amendment.
